

"What about those who have never heard of Jesus? Will they be condemned to hell?"

The Bible says that God is merciful, gracious (Psalm 103:8) and loving (1 John 4:10) and that He is not willing that any should perish (2 Peter 3:9). The Bible also says that God is going to judge with righteousness and equity (Psalm 98:9). If people have not heard about Jesus, He will judge them based on what they do know through the testimony of creation and their conscience (Romans 1:20; 2:12-15).

The Bible says that "God is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him" (Hebrews 11:6). There are many ways God can get the truth about salvation to those who truly seek to know Him. He can use a missionary (Acts 10), a radio broadcast, or a Bible (Psalm 119:130). Theoretically, God could send a vision (Daniel 2) or an angel (Revelation 14:6). The important thing for you to consider is that you have heard the truth. You have heard of Jesus' death on the cross for your sins, and God will hold you accountable for what you do with that information.
